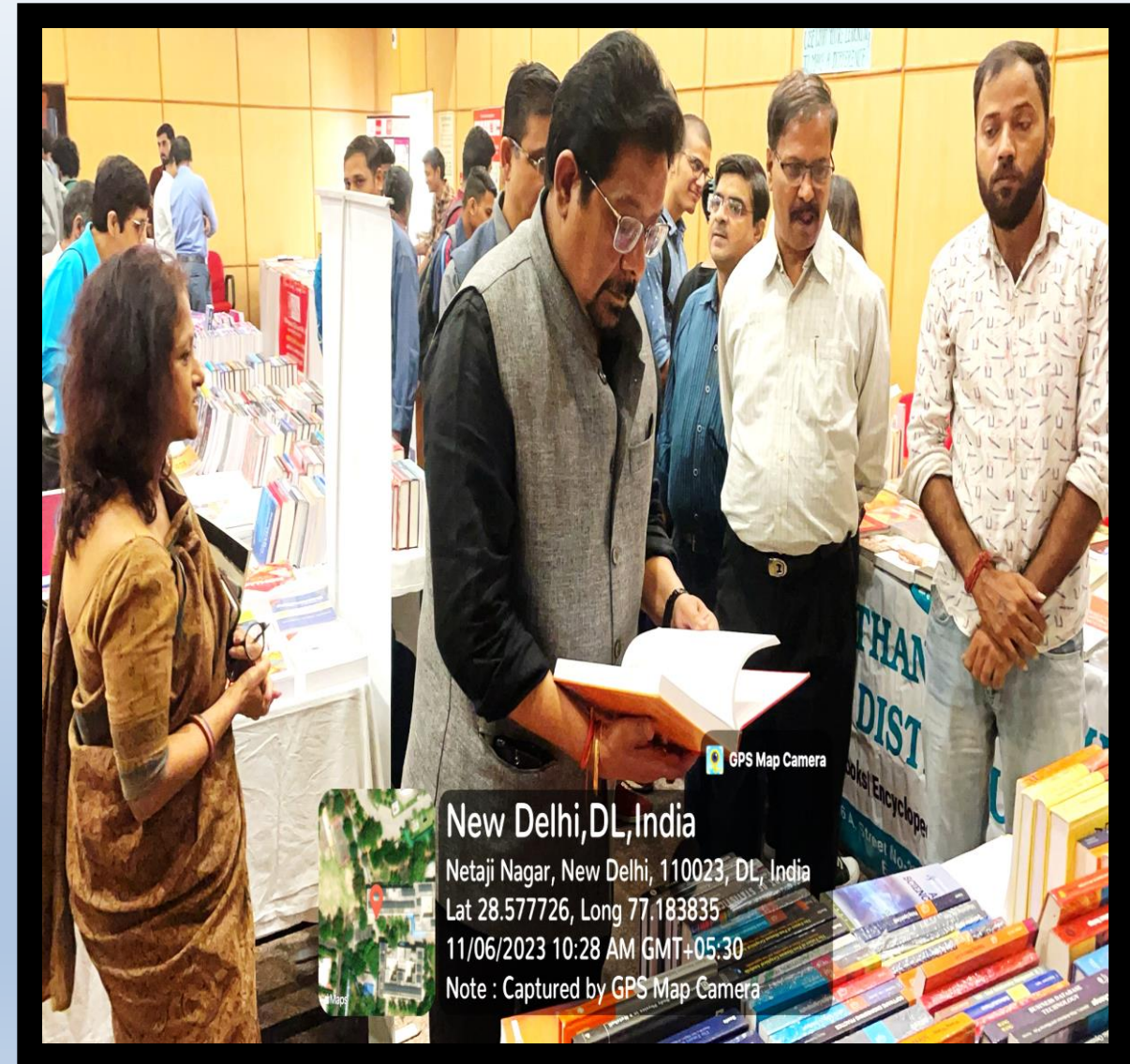
## Planning and Preparation

The proposal for the exhibition was spearheaded by Dr. Poonam Rani, the librarian. Initial brainstorming sessions defined the objectives and scope of the event. Dr. Rani created a comprehensive event plan detailing tasks, responsibilities, timelines, and budget allocations, ensuring that all aspects of the exhibition were meticulously organized and executed.

A list of approved vendors and publishers was compiled, and invitations were sent out to ensure their participation. The Multipurpose Hall was selected for its spaciousness, allowing for an engaging and accessible setup. Preparations included:

- Setting up display tables and seating arrangements
- Creating signage and promotional materials
- Displaying posters and banners to generate excitement around the event

Notices were prominently featured on the college website, and emails were sent to the TICs of various departments to ensure widespread awareness among the college community.

- **Feedback Collection:** Feedback forms were distributed by NCC student volunteers and library staff, allowing participants to share their insights and suggestions about the event.
