He said, "If death strikes me before I prove my blood, I swear l will kill death!" THE NCC SONG History

The desirability of composing a NCC song was considered in January 1956. An Official Song of NCC titled" Kadam Mila Ke Chal" was adopted in 1963 and registered in 1969 with the approval of Ministry of Defence. In 1974 it was felt that the NCC song has failed to catch the imagination of the youth and there was need for a change. In October 1982, it changed to the current NCC song titled "Hum Sabh Bhartiya Hain". This song is written by Haricharan Singh Parvana.
